PUBLIC DISPOSAL AREA ORDINANCE

Amended January 13, 1979

WHEREAS, the Township of Little Traverse may be endangered in it's public health, safety, and general walfare in the establishment and use of public dumps or public disposal areas which may be established therein, and, whereas, it becomes necessary to protect the Township in the premises,

Sec. 1. - Now, therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Board of The Township of Little Traverse, in Emmet County, Michigan, that no person, firm, co-partnership, corporation or municipal corporation shall establish, use or operate any public disposal area or public dump within said Township, except by license by the Township Board, provided, however, that the provisions of this Ordinance shall not include any public disposal area or public dump operated by The Township of Little Traverse.

Sec. 2. - Each day of such use or operation of said public disposal area or public dump shall constitute a separate offense under this Ordinance.

Sec. 3. - Any person, firm, co-partnership, corporation, or municipal corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction may be punished by being fined not more than \$100.00 and costs, or by being confined in the County Jail for not more than ninty (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.
